Financial literacy, budgeting, and more!





Clients celebrated the warm weather with a luau, featuring dinner, dancing, face-painting, and Hawaiian-themed mocktails.














SPA DAY

clients as a Program Director.


When asked what working at Spectrum for Living has taught her, Rajinder shared,
