Visitation Guidelines (Indoors & Outdoors)

- ALL VISITORS NEED TO SCHEDULE A VISIT WITH THE CLIENT COORDINATOR.
- NO MORE THAN 2 VISITORS AT ONE TIME.
- LIMIT VISITS TO 30 MINUTES.
- NO FOOD IS PERMITTED DURING THE VISIT.
- VISITS CAN BE OUTSIDE OF THE BUILDING UNDER THE FRONT AWNING.
- INDOOR VISITS ARE ONLY PERMITTED IN CONFERENCE ROOM #1. NO OTHER ACCESS TO THE BUILDING IS PERMITTED INCLUDING BATHROOMS.
- A STAFF MEMBER NEEDS TO BE AVAILABLE DURING ALL VISITS TO TRANSPORT RESIDENT WHEN VISIT STARTS AND ENDS.
- ALL VISITORS WILL NEED TO SIGN THE VISITOR BOOK ON ARRIVAL AND HAVE THIER TEMPERATURE TAKEN BY A REPRESENTATIVE AT THE FRONT DESK.
- ANYONE HAVING THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO VISIT.
- TEMERATURE OVER 99.9, COUGH, SHORTNESS OF BREATH, DIFFICULTY BREATHING, CHILLS, SORE THROAT, MUSCLE PAIN, GASTRO-INTESTINAL SYMPTOMS, HEADACHES OR LOSS OF TASTE.
- IF YOU HAVE BEEN IN CONTACT WITH SOMEONE POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 IN THE PAST 2 WEEKS, YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO VISIT.
- ALL VISITORS TO PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING- 6 FEET APART WITH A MASK ON AT ALL TIMES.
- PLEASE NO PHYSICAL CONTACT.
- ONCE YOU SIGN THE VISITOR BOOK YOU WILL NEED TO READ AND SIGN THE VISITOR AGREEMENT AND CONSENT.
